north of Camp Far West Lake, north of Lincoln (see map on back side of flyer)

#### BRUSHY CREEK AREA (off Chuck Yeager Road-driveway right hand side)

The Competitive Judged Trail Ride will test the ability of each horse/rider to maneuver through a series of creative trail obstacles (these may include: water crossing, weaving through trees/brush, log drag, picking up an object, mounting/dismounting, etc.) – trail ride is approximately 5 miles. Each obstacle will have its own judge who will individually score each horse/rider. At the conclusion of the ride, the scores from each individual judge will be tabulated per each horse/rider. Prizes and/or jackpot money will be awarded to the high places per each of the 5 age divisions (9 & under, 10-13, 14-17, 18-59, 60 & over).

START TIME FOR RIDE: Check-in starts at 7:30 a.m. (Riders' meeting at 8:15 a.m. for anyone who wants to participate.)


